Least Restrictive Environment/Placement		
511IAC 7-42-10		
Students with disabilities educated with nondisabled students to the maximum extent possible.		
Removal from the general education environment occurs only if the nature and severity of the disability is such that education in general education classes using supplementary aids and services cannot be satisfactorily achieved.A1		
The CCC determines the placement in which a student will receive services.		
A continuum of services is available to meet the individual needs of students with disabilities and makes provision for supplementary services to be provided in conjunction with general education placement.		
In selecting LRE, consideration is given to any potential harmful effect on the student or quality of services needed.		
Each student with a disability has an equal opportunity to participate with nondisabled students in nonacademic and extracurricular services and activities to the maximum extent appropriate.		
Special education and related services are delivered in the least restrictive environment determined by the CCC , regardless of the identified disability.		
The provision of services to students with different disabilities at the same time and in the same classroom is permitted.		
Students with disabilities are in classes and buildings with their chronological peers unless an alternative is determined appropriate by the CCC and the reasons for that determination are documented in the written notice required by section 6 of this rule.		
Students with disabilities are not removed from education in age-appropriate general education classrooms solely because of needed modifications in the general curriculum.		

Policy is the LEA's mandate that aligns with Article 7.

Procedures are written directives of how the LEA will operationalize those policies.
